

Adopted LWVOR Study for 2019-20

Cyber Security and Privacy Today: (proposed by Rick Bennett, Mary Sinclair, Becky Gladstone)

Study scope: We will examine established cybersecurity and privacy policies used by other organizations. We will review and catalog the ways these issues affect us today, including current Oregon legislation and proposals that address or allude to cybersecurity and/or privacy. We will consult faculty at the University of Oregon Center for Cyber Security and Privacy for assistance in focusing, prioritizing, and limiting the scope of this study. The League does not address cybersecurity at all and the only reference to privacy in our positions is limited to reproductive health care.

Proposed budget: We anticipate this study to have basic costs of staff time and printing. The Hard Rock Mining study costs provide a reasonable estimate:

- Printing costs= \$3,356.10
- Staff time=38 hours= \$600

Timeline: We do not anticipate difficulty in finding relevant sources given information already widely in use. There is a great deal of information available and the challenge will be to winnow it. Because of that, we predict being able to produce this study within League recommended timelines, for presentation of consensus questions to local Leagues by May 2020, and adoption of positions by May 2021.
